Round # 1	Online test that students have taken prior to arriving at SLC.
Round # 2	All skill procedures will be performed by teams of two students in a combined scenario. The secret scenario will be given to competitors when they compete.
Special Notes	 HOSA follows American Heart Association guidelines for CPR for healthcare providers. Steps may differ from those recommended by the American Red Cross. Students have a total of 12 minutes to complete the scenario. Please give a one minute warning and stop them at 12 minutes awarding points for where they finish on the rubrics. Judges may confer after the competitor leaves to help each other finish the scoring rubrics for an additional 5 minutes
