

ADOPT A CHAPTER

PROVIDE SOFT SCHOLARSHIPS

Many of our Montana HOSA members attend special health science conferences and/or camps during the school year and over the summer. Provide a camp or conference scholarship in the name of your business or organization.

HELP PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ATTIRE

HOSA event guidelines specify business attire: a blue or black suit, dress shoes, and shirt for conferences and competition. Your business could provide a department store gift card.

PROVIDE JOB SHADOWS

Workforce development is part of the Montana Health Science career and technical education curriculum. Let your local chapter advisor know who they may contact at your organization to schedule job shadows.

COMPENSATE YOUR EMPLOYEES FOR SERVING AS GUEST SPEAKERS AND/OR VOLUNTEERS

Montana HOSA is a registered non-profit 501(c)3 organization. If your employees volunteer with a chapter, either at the school or during a community service event, you can count their work hours as a deduction.

PROVIDE LIGHTLY USED MEDICAL EQUIPMENT

High school health science teachers struggle to provide the equipment necessary to provide hands-on experience in their classrooms and labs. Used sterile cardiac, respiratory, nursing, surg tech, pharmacy, biomed lab, physical therapy equipment may be able to find a second home.
