<b>Personnel</b>	1 judge: Judge will serve as timekeeper 1 patient:
<b>Event Supplies</b>	See Procedures Below - notepads, stopwatch, calculators, and pens/pencils for judges, intervals,
<b>Event Supplies brought by Competitor</b>	Pens/pencils, event guidelines (digital or hard copy), shoe covers, face mask, hair cover, sterile non-shedding gown w/snug cuffs, eye shield, sterile powder free- non-latex gloves
<b>Registration</b>	Secondary =
<b>Dress Code</b>	Attire appropriate to the occupational area
<b>Student Orientation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Explain the event to the students</li> <li>- Ask for student questions</li> <li>- Distribute appointment times to all students</li> <li>- Students will receive their Secret Scenario when they report back to begin the event. Remind students the Secret Scenario is to be kept secret so as not to give unfair advantage to anyone.</li> </ul>
<b>Round # 1</b>	Online test that students have taken prior to arriving at SLC.
<b>Round # 2</b>	<b>Students will demonstrate two skills explained in the secret scenario. It is important that you treat each competitor the same, or as similarly as possible. Time and stop competitors at the end of the allowed time for each skill</b>
